- What has been found in previous studies?
- What suggestions do other researchers make for further study?
- What has not been investigated?
- How can the proposed study add to our knowledge of the area?
- What research methods were used in previous studies?

GUIDELINES IN THE CONDUCT OF LITERATURE REVIEW

- It defines a specific hypothesis or research question
- Hypothesis is a formal statement regarding the relationship between variables, and it is tested directly. It is a predicted relationship between the variables either true or false.
- Research question is a formally stated question intended to provide indications about something and it is not limited to investigating relationships between variables.
